


April 11 - **Matthew 27:27-31**  
**Soldiers Mock Jesus**



31 When they had mocked him, they took the robe off of him, and put his clothes on him, and led him away to crucify him.

31 και ὅτε ἐνέπαιξαν αὐτῷ, ἐξέδυσαν αὐτὸν τὴν χλαμύδα καὶ ἐνέδυσαν αὐτὸν τὰ ἱμάτια αὐτοῦ καὶ ἀπήγαγον αὐτὸν εἰς τὸ σταυρῶσαι.

29 They braided a crown of thorns and put it on his head; and they kneeled down before him, and mocked him, saying, "Hail, King of the Jews!"  
 30 They spat on him, and took the reed and struck him on the head.

29 καὶ πλέξαντες στέφανον ἐξ ἀκανθῶν ἐπέθηκαν ἐπὶ τῆς κεφαλῆς αὐτοῦ καὶ κάλαμον ἐν τῇ δεξιᾷ αὐτοῦ, καὶ γονυπετήσαντες ἔμπροσθεν αὐτοῦ ἐνέπαιξαν αὐτῷ λέγοντες **Χαῖρε, βασιλεῦ τῶν Ἰουδαίων,**  
 30 καὶ ἐμππύσαντες εἰς αὐτὸν ἔλαβον τὸν κάλαμον καὶ ἔτυπτον εἰς τὴν κεφαλὴν αὐτοῦ.

27 Then the governor's soldiers took Jesus into the Praetorium, and gathered the whole garrison together against him.  
 28 They stripped him, and put a scarlet robe on him.

 28 καὶ ἐκδύσαντες αὐτὸν χλαμύδα κοκκίνην περιέθηκαν αὐτῷ,
