

February 14 - **Matthew 13:1-9**
The Parable of the Sower

4 καὶ ἐν τῷ σπείρειν αὐτὸν ἃ μὲν ἔπεσεν παρὰ τὴν ὁδὸν, καὶ ἔλθόντα τὰ πετεινὰ κατέφαγεν αὐτά.

4 As he sowed, some seeds fell by the roadside, and the birds came and devoured them.

3 καὶ ἐλάλησεν αὐτοῖς πολλὰ ἐν παραβολαῖς λέγων Ἴδοὺ ἐξῆλθεν ὁ σπείρων τοῦ σπείρειν.

3 He spoke to them many things in parables, saying, "Behold, a farmer went out to sow.

1 Ἐν τῇ ἡμέρᾳ ἐκείνῃ ἐξελθὼν ὁ Ἰησοῦς τῆς οἰκίας ἐκάθητο παρὰ τὴν θάλασσαν·
 2 καὶ συνήχθησαν πρὸς αὐτὸν ὄχλοι πολλοί, ὥστε αὐτὸν εἰς πλοῖον ἐμβάντα καθῆσθαι, καὶ πᾶς ὁ ὄχλος ἐπὶ τὸν αἰγιαλὸν ἰσθήκει.

1 On that day Jesus went out of the house, and sat by the seaside.
 2 Great multitudes gathered to him, so that he entered into a boat, and sat, and all the multitude stood on the beach.

5 Ἄλλοι δὲ ἔπεσεν ἐπὶ τὰ πετρώδη ὅπου οὐκ εἶχεν γῆν πολλήν, καὶ εὐθέως ἐξανέτειλεν διὰ τὸ μὴ ἔχειν βάθος γῆς,
 6 ἠλίου δὲ ἀνατείλαντος ἐκαυματίσθη καὶ διὰ τὸ μὴ ἔχειν ῥίζαν ἐξηράνθη.

5 Others fell on rocky ground, where they didn't have much soil, and immediately they sprang up, because they had no depth of earth.
 6 When the sun had risen, they were scorched. Because they had no root, they withered away.

7 Ἄλλοι δὲ ἔπεσεν ἐπὶ τὰς ἀκάνθας, καὶ ἀνέβησαν αἱ ἀκάνθαι καὶ ἐπνιξαν αὐτά.


7 Others fell among thorns. The thorns grew up and choked them:

8 Ἄλλοι δὲ ἔπεσεν ἐπὶ τὴν γῆν τὴν καλὴν καὶ ἐδίδου καρπὸν, ὁ μὲν ἑκατὸν, ὁ δὲ ἐξήκοντα, ὁ δὲ τριάκοντα.

8 and others fell on good soil, and yielded fruit: some one hundred times as much, some sixty, and some thirty.

9 Ὁ ἔχων ὦτα ἀκούετω.

9 He who has ears to hear, let him hear."
