
February 18 - **Matthew 13:44-50**
Hidden Treasure and Pearl
Parable of the Net

44 Ὅμοια ἐστὶν ἡ βασιλεία τῶν οὐρανῶν θησαυρῷ κεκρυμμένῳ ἐν τῷ ἀγρῷ, ὃν εὕρων ἄνθρωπος ἔκρυψεν, καὶ ἀπὸ τῆς χαρᾶς αὐτοῦ ὑπάγει καὶ πωλεῖ ὅσα ἔχει καὶ ἀγοράζει τὸν ἀγρὸν ἐκεῖνον.

44 "Again, the Kingdom of Heaven is like a treasure hidden in the field, which a man found, and hid. In his joy, he goes and sells all that he has, and buys that field.

45 Πάλιν ὁμοία ἐστὶν ἡ βασιλεία τῶν οὐρανῶν ἐμπόρῳ ζητοῦντι καλοῦς μαργαρίτας·
 46 εὕρων δὲ ἓνα πολύτιμον μαργαρίτην ἀπελθὼν πέπρακεν πάντα ὅσα εἶχεν καὶ ἠγόρασεν αὐτόν.

45 "Again, the Kingdom of Heaven is like a merchant seeking fine pearls,
 46 who having found one pearl of great price, he went and sold all that he had, and bought it.



47 Πάλιν ὁμοία ἐστὶν ἡ βασιλεία τῶν οὐρανῶν σαγήνη βληθεῖση εἰς τὴν θάλασσαν καὶ ἐκ παντὸς γένους συναγαγούσῃ·
 48 ἣν ὅτε ἐπληρώθη ἀναβίβασαντες ἐπὶ τὸν αἰγιαλὸν καὶ καθίσαντες συνέλεξαν τὰ καλὰ εἰς ἄγγη, τὰ δὲ σαπρὰ ἔξω ἔβαλον.

47 "Again, the Kingdom of Heaven is like a dragnet, that was cast into the sea, and gathered some fish of every kind,
 48 which, when it was filled, they drew up on the beach. They sat down, and gathered the good into containers, but the bad they threw away.

49 οὕτως ἔσται ἐν τῇ συντελείᾳ τοῦ αἰῶνος· οἱ ἀγγελοὶ καὶ ἀπορροῦσιν τοὺς ἐκ τῶν αἰώνων ἀμάρτων, καὶ βαλοῦσιν αὐτοὺς εἰς τὴν πυρᾶν· ἐκεῖ ἔσται ὁ κλαυθμὸς καὶ ὁ βουγμός τῶν ὀδόντων.

49 So will it be in the end of the world: the angels will come forth, and separate the wicked from the righteous, and will cast them into the furnace of fire. There will be the weeping and the gnashing of teeth."
