


Sept 10 - Luke 18:31-34  
**Jesus' Death and Resurrection**

31 He took the twelve aside, and said to them, "Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and all the things that are written through the prophets concerning the Son of Man will be completed. 32 For he will be delivered up to the Gentiles, will be mocked, treated shamefully, and spit on.

31 Παραλαβὼν δὲ τοὺς δώδεκα εἶπεν πρὸς αὐτούς Ἴδου ἀναβαίνομεν εἰς Ἱερουσαλήμ, καὶ τελεσθήσεται πάντα τὰ γεγραμμένα διὰ τῶν προφητῶν τῷ υἱῷ τοῦ ἀνθρώπου· 32 παραδοθήσεται γὰρ τοῖς ἔθνεσιν καὶ ἐμπαιθήσεται καὶ ὑβρισθήσεται καὶ ἐμπτυσθήσεται,

33 καὶ μαστιγώσαντες ἀποκτενοῦσιν αὐτόν, καὶ τῇ ἡμέρᾳ τῇ τρίτῃ ἀναστήσεται.  
 33 They will scourge and kill him. On the third day, he will rise again."



34 They understood none of these things. This saying was hidden from them, and they didn't understand the things that were said.

34 Καὶ αὐτοὶ οὐδὲν τούτων συνῆκαν, καὶ ἦν τὸ ῥῆμα τοῦτο κεκρυμμένον ἀπ' αὐτῶν, καὶ οὐκ ἐγίνωσκον τὰ λεγόμενα.

 Received his sight and followed Jesus (43, 42, 41, 40) Brought to Jesus (37, 36, 35, 38) A blind man sat (39) Son of David, have mercy on me (38)

**18:31-34 Jesus Predicts Again His Death and Resurrection**  
 Kill him. He will rise again (33) Delivered and mocked (32) They didn't understand (34) 31

**18:18-30 The Rich Ruler**  
 A Ruler sad about giving up his wealth (30, 29) We have left everything (28) Possible with God (27) Hard for those who have riches (24, 25) 23, 21, 18, 22, 19, 20

**18:1-8 Parable of the Widow and the Judge**  
 Always pray (1) A judge and a widow (2, 3) I will defend her (4, 5) Won't God avenge his chosen ones (6, 7, 8)

**18:9-14 Parable of the Pharisee and the Tax Collector**  
 A pharisee and a tax collector (10, 9) I am not like the rest of men (11, 12) God, be merciful (13) The tax collector justified (14)

**18:15-17 Let the Children Come to Me**  
 Bringing babies (15) The Kingdom of God belongs to such as these (16, 17)
