

41 He said to them, "Why do they say that the Christ is David's son?"

41 Εἶπεν δὲ πρὸς αὐτοὺς Πῶς λέγουσιν τὸν χριστὸν εἶναι Δαυειδ υἱόν;

45 In the hearing of all the people, he said to his disciples,
46 "Beware of the scribes, who like to walk in long robes, and love greetings in the marketplaces, the best seats in the synagogues, and the best places at feasts;
47 who devour widows' houses, and for a pretense make long prayers: these will receive greater condemnation."

45 Ἀκούοντος δὲ παντὸς τοῦ λαοῦ εἶπεν τοῖς μαθηταῖς
46 Προσέχετε ἀπὸ τῶν γραμματέων τῶν θελόντων περιπατεῖν ἐν στολαῖς καὶ φιλοῦντων ἀσπασμούς ἐν ταῖς ἀγοραῖς καὶ πρωτοκαθεδρίας ἐν ταῖς συναγωγαῖς καὶ πρωτοκλισίας ἐν τοῖς δεῖπνοις,
47 οἱ κατασθίουσιν τὰς οἰκίας τῶν χηρῶν καὶ προφάσει μακρὰ προσεύχονται· οὗτοι λήμψονται περισσότερον κρίμα.

42 David himself says in the book of Psalms, 'The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at my right hand,
43 Until I make your enemies the footstool of your feet."

42 αὐτὸς γὰρ Δαυειδ λέγει ἐν Βίβλῳ Ψαλμῶν Εἶπεν Κύριος τῷ κυρίῳ μου Κάθου ἐκ δεξιῶν μου
43 ἕως ἂν θῶ τοὺς ἐχθροὺς σου ὑποπόδιον τῶν ποδῶν σου·

44 "David therefore calls him Lord, so how is he his son?"

44 Δαυειδ οὖν αὐτὸν κύριον καλεῖ, καὶ πῶς αὐτοῦ υἱὸς ἐστίν;
